Dear Parent/Guardian,

Late last night, two (2) confirmed cases of COVID-19 in the State of Michigan were announced by Governor Whitmer. As a preventative measure, the Governor also declared a “state of emergency”.

Preventative measures that the Woodhaven-Brownstown School District continue to reinforce include:

- Frequent hand washing with warm soapy water for at least 20 seconds
- When soap and water is not available, use hand sanitizer to wash hands
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue or sleeve
- Staying home if sick; if feeling ill, seek medical care

Please know, at the initial onset of this year’s flu season, the District began the process of systematically and routinely disinfecting and deep cleaning high traffic areas in each building, such as door handles, bathrooms, cafeterias, and classrooms. More recently, we implemented the additional measure of disinfecting our school buses multiple times throughout the day.

These measures represent our best resources in preventing the spread of COVID-19 and other contagious diseases. **WE NEED YOUR HELP.** Please continue to reinforce these preventative measures at home, especially the hand washing and keeping children home if feeling sick or ill.

As a school district, we will continue to monitor and implement the recommendations of the CDC and will work closely with the Wayne County Health Department. As needed, I will continue to provide you with information and updates as they develop.
